## WEEK OF PRAYER FOR CHRISTIAN UNITY

### WHAT IS IT?

The Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is an ecumenical annual celebration. Christians around the world are invited to pray for the unity of all Christians, to reflect on scripture together, to participate jointly-organized in ecumenical services. and share to fellowship.

## WHEN DOES IT TAKE PLACE?



In the northern hemisphere, the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity is traditionally held every year between January 18th (the Feast of the Confession of Saint Peter) and January 25th (the Feast of the Conversion of Saint Paul). In the southern hemisphere, it is often celebrated during the Pentecost season. All are invited to pray for Christian unity during the WPCU and to deepen their knowledge of the Nicene Creed.
