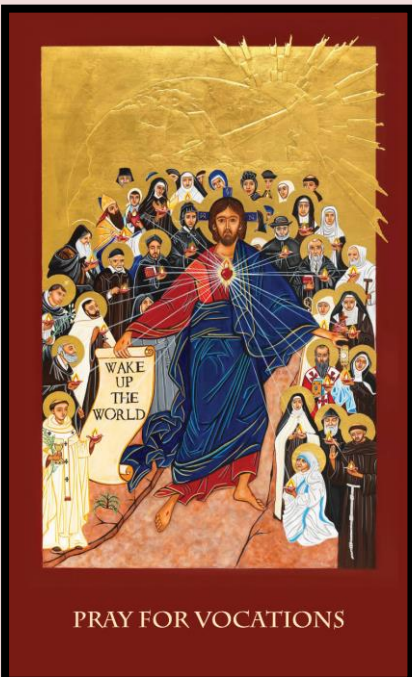

THE JUBILEE PRAYER

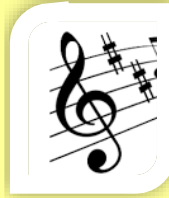
Father in heaven,
