Here are the ways you can give:

Time of Personal Prayer



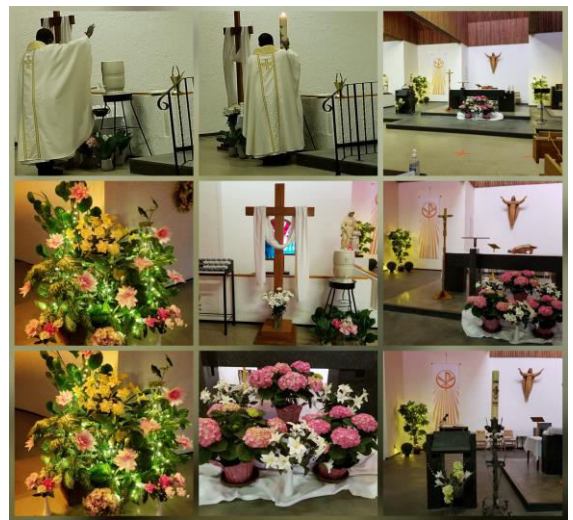
Holy Thursday
