## Temporary Liturgical Changes in Response to COVID-19

In recent days, questions have risen surrounding the need for changes to our liturgical practices in light of the coronavirus outbreak.

As a matter of prudence, Bishop Don has asked that we institute the following changes, effective immediately:

- Replace handshaking, at the sign of Peace, with a bow and spoken word of peace.
- Communion to be distributed under the species of bread alone.
- Parishioners who are ill are asked to stay home to avoid spreading illness to others.
- All Holy water bowls to be emptied.

- The four-week average for Sunday collection (including automatic deposits) is \$2,479.
- The two-year comparison is \$2,785.
- Budget expectation (excluding the special Easter and Christmas offerings) is \$2,796.
