TREE OF LIFE LEGACY CAMPAIGN UPDATE





GREEN RIBBON CAMPAIGN

JANUARY 28 & 29, 2023

Regina Pro-Life is sponsoring the Green Ribbon Campaign to remember our preborn brothers and sisters, who were denied life. We specifically ask that you pray for the preborn and for women in crisis pregnancy.

On January 28, 1988, the Supreme Court of Canada issued the Morgentaler decision, which struck down abortion as part of the criminal code. Since then, there have been no laws whatsoever to regulate abortion in Canada through all nine months of pregnancy. On January 28th, wear a green ribbon and remember the millions of Canadians, who have lost their lives to abortion.
