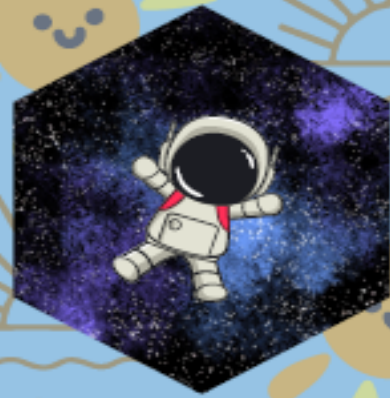

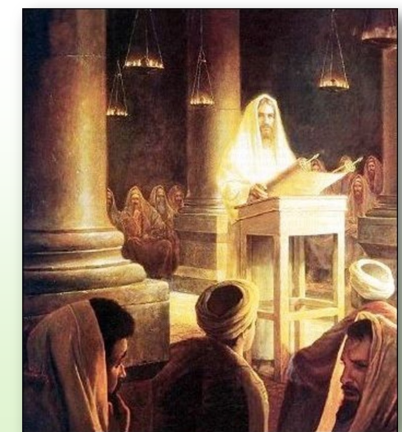

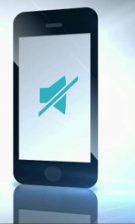
GO MAKE DISCIPLES
