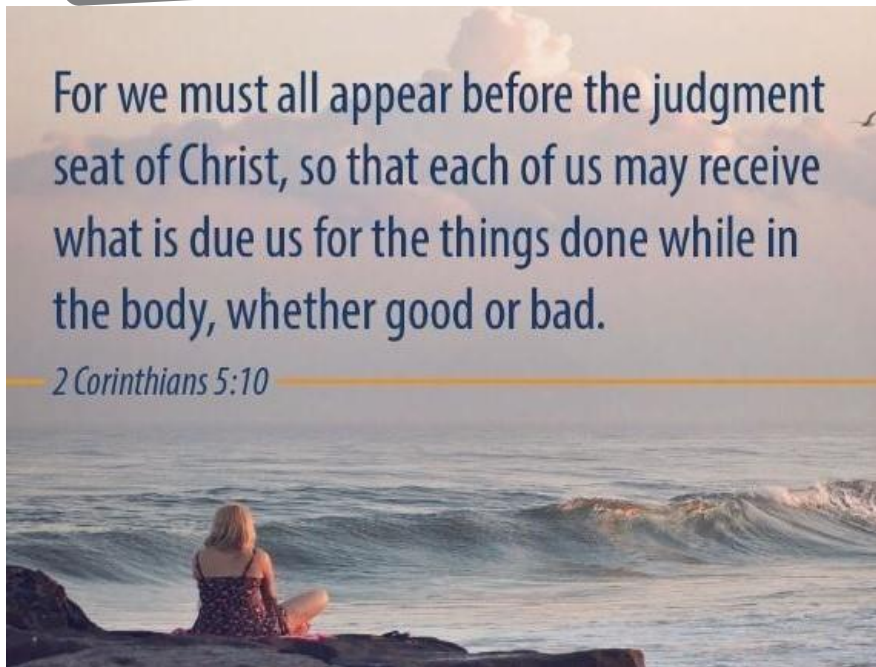

CFL Football Pool Tickets

The return of CFL football means the return of the Knights of Columbus football pool. This has traditionally been one of the fun activities that St. Anne's has participated in over the years and most of the profits from the ticket sales have gone to support activities in our church.

The tickets are \$20, with payouts made for 21 games (18 regular season games and 3 play off games). For any games that are cancelled, (the first 4 games so far) the payout will be made based on sixteen separate random scores. Payouts will be made exactly like a regularly played game. If your score comes up during the game, you will receive a cheque in the mail for \$20.00. If your score is matched at the end of a quarter, you will receive \$60.00 and at the end of game you will receive \$125.
