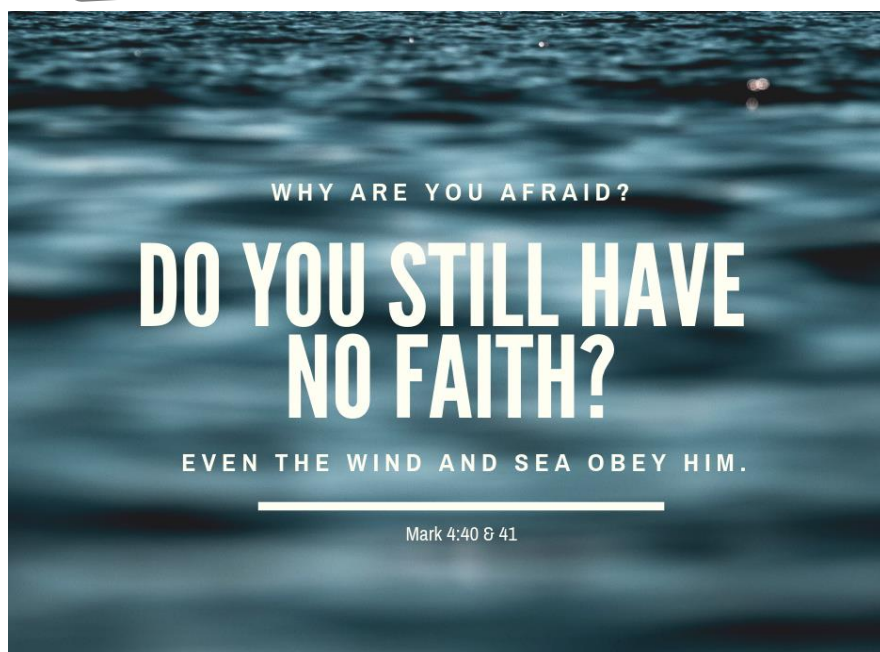
Mass Intention
