
## **Mass Intention**

The Good Neighbour Project is a long-time outreach of our parish and has never seen so much demand! We have been assisting 2-3 families per week since the beginning of the year.

Families are receiving new and gently used small household items that are donated by parishioners and the wider community. Some of the things that families need when starting a new household are not often donated. We need money to help fill in the gaps. We buy things like pillows, kettles, toasters and garbage cans, hygiene items and cleaning supplies. The items we give families are so highly valued by the people who receive them and relieve a stress on families already in dire circumstances. SGI will once again be giving rebate cheques of \$100/vehicle.
