Here are the ways you can give:

- **Sunday collection** – make sure you are registered as a parishioner and have envelopes so that we know to give you a tax receipt. Then, each Sunday (or Saturday), place your envelope with cheque or cash in the collection basket.
- **Automatic deposit** – all you need to do is provide a void cheque and indicate the amount and frequency (weekly or monthly). You can give this information to the office or just throw it in the collection basket, and it will make it's way to the office.
- **E-transfer** – send e-transfer donations to office@stannesregina.com.

2021 Envelopes are still available at the Parish Office if you would like to get one. Donating with church envelopes allows your donation to be recorded for you to be issued a tax receipt.
