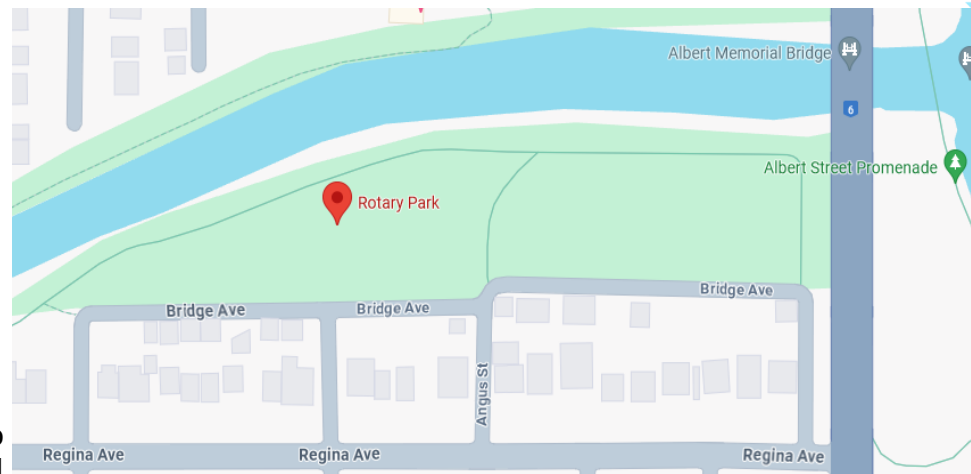


**Peace Vigil

PEACE VIGIL IN ROTARY PARK


Victoria Day You are invited to join with other people of good will to pray and reflect on peace in the world. Organized by KAIROS Regina, this is a simple invitation to gather for some time together, and to remember those who are victims of war and violence.

WHERE: Peace Pole in Rotary Park between Angus and Rae St (immediately beside the Albert St Bridge).

WHEN: Victoria Day, May 20 at 2pm

- Gather at the Peace Pole in Rotary Park for some quiet conversation, prayers, and songs.
- If it is sunny, bring a blanket, chair, and guitar, and wear sunscreen.
- Feel free to bring a prayer or song of peace to share.
- We welcome those who wish to gather in peace. We have no agenda, and we ask you to leave any agenda or banners at home.

* A peace pole is a monument that displays the message "May Peace Prevail on Earth" in the language of the country where it has been placed, and usually additional translations. The message often is referred to as a peace prayer. The original wooden Peace Pole in Rotary Park was erected by the Rotary Clubs of Regina in 2000 and replaced with a metal pole in 2023.

"There are different kinds of spiritual gifts but the same Spirit; there are different forms of service but the same Lord; there are different workings but the same God who produces all of them in everyone."

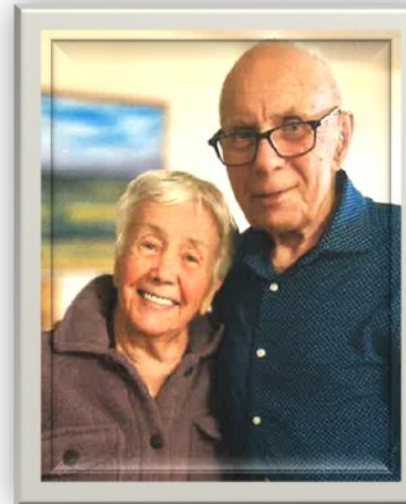
1 Corinthians 12:4-6
