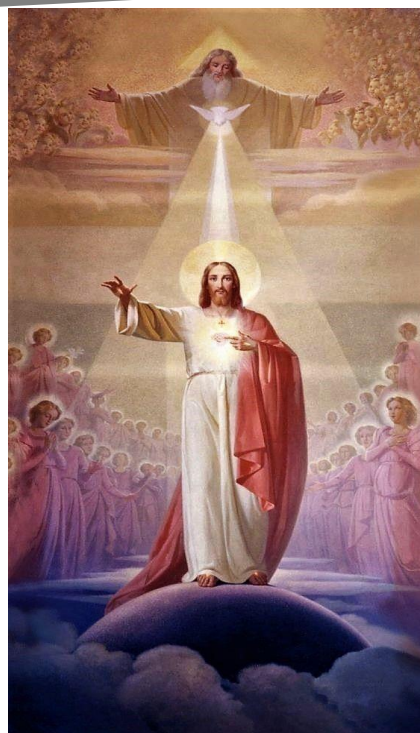
## **Mass Intention**

Here are the ways you can give:

### CFL Football Pool Tickets

The tickets are \$20, with payouts made for 21 games (18 regular season games and 3 play off games). For any games that are cancelled, (the first 4 games so far) the payout will be made based on sixteen separate random scores. Payouts will be made exactly like a regularly played game. If your score comes up during the game, you will receive a cheque in the mail for \$20.00. If your score is matched at the end of a quarter, you will receive \$60.00 and at the end of game you will receive \$125.

### Saskatchewan's Re-Opening Roadmap

#### **In Step 1, beginning this Sunday, May 30:**

- maximum capacity of a place of worship will be increased to 30% of seating capacity, with a maximum of 150 people in the entire facility, whichever is less.
- for this coming weekend, please remember that the maximum number of people that can be in the church on **Saturday, May 29, is still 30 persons**. The new guidelines do not come into effect until Sunday morning).
- 2-meter distancing, masking, sanitizing, and contact tracing will continue to be required.
- sharing food or drink is prohibited in Step 1.
- other non-worship gatherings will be allowed to a maximum of 30 people.
- non-worship gatherings held concurrently with a worship service are allowed, but the total number of people in the building may not exceed 30% of capacity to a maximum of 150 people, whichever is less.
- worship gatherings may be held concurrently in different spaces, as long as the maximum number of people for the building does not exceed 30% of capacity to a maximum of 150 people, whichever is less.
- non-essential travel is not recommended outside Saskatchewan.
