IMPORTANT – >> SCAM ALERT <<

Please be aware that some emails are being sent from scammers claiming to be some of our priests and office staff. Names are being pulled from parish and diocesan websites to create fake email (often Gmail) accounts. You will notice the email address may have some correct info, though in an unfamiliar form with additional characters, numbers, or periods. Most will ask you to contact them or send information. Please do not reply to any suspicious emails. If you are in doubt, contact the person the email is claiming to be from using an alternate contact method (**DO NOT REPLY TO THE SUSPICIOUS EMAIL**). Also note: At no time will our priests, deacons, religious or diocesan staff contact you seeking Google Play cards, iTunes cards or any other form of personal financial assistance.

Conquest's "In the Spirit of St. Nicholas" project is an early advent initiative aimed at promoting the example of charity that the saints provide for us.
