

# The Catechism: from zero to hero in 3 minutes!

Is the *Catechism of the Catholic Church* a "universal Catechism"?

Yes, because it is to be used as the reference point for all local catechisms throughout the Universal Church. In an earlier draft. the Catechism of the Catholic Church was titled the Catechism of the Universal Church, but never used. Local catechisms are created according to the needs of a specific culture, age, spiritual life. social and ecclesial conditions. The current Catechism of the Catholic Church was given by Saint John Paul II on the 30<sup>th</sup> anniversary of Vatican II on October 11th, 1992 and 2022 marked the 60<sup>th</sup> anniversary.
