Dear St. Anne's Parish,

Thank you for your continued generosity in supporting the Parish through volunteering and donations to the collection. I will be providing a financial update in September, once we have the August results.

I explained at the Annual General Meeting (AGM) earlier this year, that the Parish was able to significantly reduce the building repair loan that we have from the Archdiocese in 2022 as the result of a significant and generous bequest of \$150,000. This meant that all the funds raised from the successful Tree of Life 60<sup>th</sup> Anniversary fundraiser could remain in the Parish and help address the on-going capital requirements of a sixty-year-old building. The total debt decreased from \$299,736 at December 31, 2021 to \$153,780 at December 31, 2022

I also presented our 2023 budget at the Annual General Meeting, which required donations to the Building Fund of \$56,000 to continue with the debt repayment. The advantage of donating to the Building Fund, as opposed to just general collections, is the St. Anne's Parish can send 100% of the Building Fund donations as debt repayment to the Archdiocese. General collections to St. Anne's Parish are shared with the Archdiocese, through an assessment process which Father Amedee jokingly calls "the tax". It is the way that the Parish able to support the good work that the Archdiocese does on our behalf.

St. Anne's Parish has a continuing need to raise funds to repay our debt of \$153,780, and I would like to ask all parishioners to consider donating to the Building Fund in 2023. I know everyone's financial situation is different, and we are all on different places on our journey through life. But I know that we can all look forward to that glorious day four years from now, and the debt is finally retired, so we can start to consider some other larger capital projects, like repaving the parking lot and relaying the paving stones South of the hall. Maybe even fixing the leaky roof, permanently!

There are specially labeled envelopes that read "Building Fund" at the parking lot entrance that can be used to drop cheques or cash in the collections basket.
