Dear St. Anne's Parish,

You might have already noticed that the Buildings & Grounds Committee is moving ahead with the replacement of the sidewalk on the north side of the Rectory. The sidewalk has sunk relative to the rest of the building (ah, the joys of Hillsdale!), making the north

Rectory door unusable, and posing a risk to water damage to the basement. The contractor expects to pour the concrete on September 22. Once the forms are removed, they will add topsoil between the sidewalk and the rectory, so that there is an appropriate grade. This phase of the project is expected to take two weeks. Next spring, in the area between the new sidewalk and the road will be backfilled and grass will be seeded.

Many thanks to the Buildings and Grounds Committee: **Kelly Nelson**, **Bert Perrault** and **Marc Raymond** for leading this project, and the excellent work that they do all year long in making sure St. Anne's is a welcoming, safe and comfortable parish. If you would like to assist them, as many hands make light work, in the building's upkeep, such as changing furnace filters, washing windows and light painting, etc., please let Gabriela at the main office know.
